

RED WING ROYAL AMBASSADOR CANDIDATE RULES OF CONDUCT

This statement of policy has been prepared to provide a clear and pleasant relationship between the Red Wing Royal Ambassador Organization, hereafter to be listed as 'Program Committee', and the Ambassador Candidates, as to the conduct expected of Candidates.

I) While the Program Committee has no right to legislate the private lives of its candidates, the Candidates should constantly bear in mind that, as ambassadors for the City of Red Wing, their conduct, reflects on this community. Please be aware of the following:

- A) A Candidate shall not at any time, regardless of the quantity,
 - 1. use, consume or have in possession a beverage containing alcohol;
 - 2. use, consume or have in possession tobacco; or,
 - 3. use, consume or have in possession, buy, sell or give away any other controlled substance; The Candidate will be immediately dismissed from participation in the Ambassador Program.
- B) If arrested for any misdemeanor or greater offense you are subject to disciplinary action that could result in the immediate dismissal of the Candidate from the Red Wing Royal Ambassador Program.
- C) If you are or become pregnant during your time as an Ambassador Candidate, you will be asked to forfeit your position as a Candidate.
- D) If a Candidate is dismissed from the Royal Ambassador program, the Candidate will be required to repay all expenses to the Program Committee and/or the Candidate's Sponsor. This fee will be at the digression of the Program Committee.

II) Requests for personal appearances by the Ambassador Candidates must be approved by the Chairperson of the Program Committee.

III) Before making any plans to be absent from Red Wing or taking a long trip, the Ambassador Candidates should consult with the Pageant Director or the Chairperson of the Program Committee in order to facilitate the scheduling of events.

IV) The Ambassador Candidates should not request of their official escorts adjustments of set plans or make necessary a premature departure from an event or community appearance.

V) Ambassador Candidates shall not authorize any charges (clothing etc...) against the Program Committee.

VI) If you are unable to attend an organized parade or appearance, PLEASE contact your a committee member from the Program Committee beforehand.
